SR 924/Gratigny Parkway

Mainline Closure

Alternate lanes on eastbound and westbound SR 924 will be closed just west of the SR 924 toll plaza for Open Road Tolling (ORT) equipment improvements. The closure will take place daily beginning **Sunday, April 18 through Friday, April 23 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and again nightly from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.**

Street Closure

One right lane on southbound NW 57th Avenue/West 4th Avenue (Red Road) will be closed between NW 135th Street/West 84th Street and SR 924 for signage structure foundation installation. The lane will close on **Monday, April 19 at 9 a.m. and will re-open on Tuesday, April 20 at 3 p.m.**

Street Closure

Alternate lanes on southbound and northbound NW 57th Avenue/West 4th Avenue (Red Road) will be closed on the approach to SR 924 for signage structure installation. The closure will place nightly beginning **Monday, April 19 through Friday, April 23 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.**

Overhead gantries will replace traditional toll plazas and tolls will automatically be calculated and deducted from your SunPass account. ORT will make driving on MDX expressways FASTER (reduces congestion), SAFER (no toll plaza incidents), CLEANER (reduces emissions), FAIR (pay for only the portion of road you travel) and will help fund roadway improvements for the FUTURE.
