SR 874/Don Shula Expressway

Lane Closure

Alternate lanes on southbound SR 874 will be closed just before SW 117th Avenue for bridge joint improvements. The closure will take place for 8 hours nightly beginning **Sunday, June 27 through Wednesday, June 30 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.**

Ramp Closure

The exit ramp from southbound SR 874 to northbound SW 107th Avenue will be closed for privacy wall construction. The closure will take place for 6.5 hours daily beginning **Monday, June 28 through Friday, July 2 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.**

Detour:

Motorists traveling on southbound SR 874 should exit at SW 104th Street (Killian Parkway) and turn left. Turn right at SW 108th Avenue (East Perimeter Road). Turn right at SW 100th Street and turn left to access northbound SW 107th Avenue.

Lane Closure

Alternate lanes on northbound SR 874 will be closed just before SW 117th Avenue for bridge joint improvements. The closure will take place for 8 hours nightly beginning **Tuesday, June 29 through Friday, July 2 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.**

Lane Closure

Two right lanes on southbound SR 874 will be closed just before SW 104th Street (Killian Parkway) for utility installation. The lanes will close for 8.5 hours on **Tuesday, June 29 at 9 p.m. and will re-open on Wednesday, June 30 at 5:30 a.m.**

Lane Closure

The right lane on eastbound and westbound SW 104th Street (Killian Parkway) will be closed intermittently at SW 107th Avenue for construction and sign installation. The right lane on southbound SW 107th Avenue will also be closed. The closure will take place intermittently for 6.5 hours beginning **Monday, June 28 through Friday, July 2 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.**

Lane Closure

Alternate lanes on southbound and northbound SR 874 will be closed between the SR 874 toll plaza and SW 88th Street (Kendall Drive) for construction. The closure will take place for 8.5 hours nightly beginning **Monday, June 28 through Friday, July 2 from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.**

FDOT Multiple Lane and Ramp Closures

As part of the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) SR 826/Palmetto Expressway Project, the following closure will impact the MDX system at the merger of northbound SR 874 with SR 826/Palmetto Expressway:

- Sunday, June 27 through Monday, June 28: All northbound lanes on the SR 826/ Palmetto Expressway will be detoured south of SW 40th Street (Bird Road) from 11 p.m., Sunday, June 27, until 5:30 a.m., Monday, June 28, in order to shift traffic west. Drivers going north on SR 874 will have the option of getting off at SW 88th Street (Kendall Drive) to avoid the detour. The detour is as follows:

Northbound drivers on SR 826 and SR 874 will exit at SW 40th Street (Bird Road), go east on SW 40 Street/Bird Road, go north on SW 67th Avenue and go west on SW 24 Street (Coral Way) where they may access the northbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway on ramp.
