## MDX TRAFFIC ADVISORY – July 15, 2010

### SR 874/Don Shula Expressway

A previously advertised southbound SR 874 entrance ramp closure has been extended due to inclement weather. The closure will now take place as follows:

#### Ramp Closure

The entrance ramp to southbound SR 874 from westbound SW 104<sup>th</sup> Street (Killian Parkway) and from southbound SW 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue is currently closed for drainage installation. **The ramp will re-open on Friday, July 16 at 4 p.m.**

#### Detour:

Motorists wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike will continue west on SW 104<sup>th</sup> Street (Killian Parkway) and turn left at SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Continue south on SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue and turn right onto SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street. Continue on SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street to access the ramp to southbound Florida's Turnpike on the right.
