



AESTHETIC ENHANCEMENT POLICY

PURPOSE

It is the policy of the Greater Miami Expressway Agency (GMX) to incorporate aesthetically pleasing features into its facilities to enhance the quality of life of all that drive them. Enhancements shall mean, but not be limited to: greenways; bike paths; roadside parks and rest areas; water bodies and lake ways; noise mitigation features or structures; landscape, lighting and xeriscape improvements; large scale public art; and unique and aesthetically pleasing architectural features of the GMX system.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

1. Agency staff shall implement this policy through the development and use of an Aesthetics Enhancements Manual.
2. In the development of enhancement plans for specific projects, the Agency will confer with Florida Department of Transportation Guidelines, Miami-Dade County's Neat Streets Miami and Transportation Aesthetic Review Committee (TARC), as well as with the Monroe County Board of Parks and Recreation and the Art in Public Places (AIPP) Committee, as applicable.

This policy shall be effective on the date on which it is adopted by the Governing Board.
